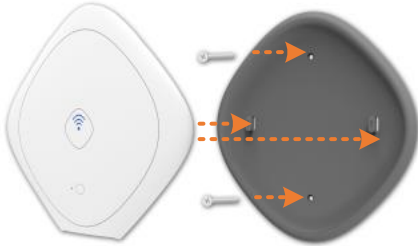

Administrator

1 Install and power on

Place device in open area, high off the floor, away from magnetic and large metal objects, and at least 1 meter from clients. If desired, mount it on the wall or ceiling.



Connect power supply and network cable.

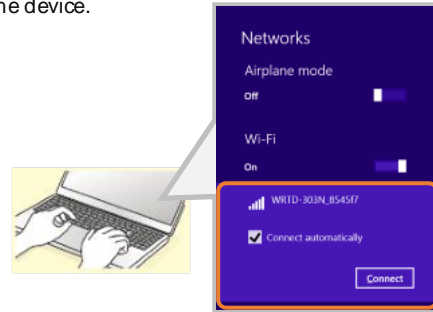


Press and hold the power button for 2 seconds to turn on the device.



2 Connect to Content Access Point

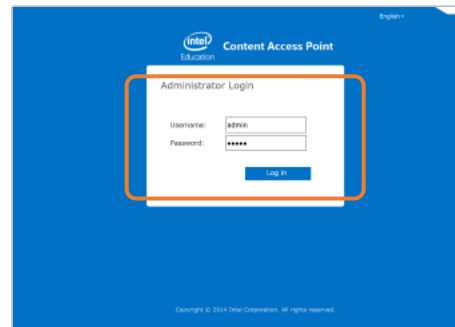
Wirelessly connect to the device. The default SSID is iWRTD-303N_0 plus the last 6 digits of the WFM ID that is printed on the bottom of the device.



3 Configure Admin account


Open browser and go to <http://my.admin> (or <http://192.168.88.1:8080>).

Use default username: *admin* and password: *admin* to log in. Set a new password when prompted.




4 Complete Setup Wizard


Use the *Setup Wizard* to quickly configure the device.



On the *Wireless Settings* step, set the SSID name of the device to something recognizable and select a Security Mode (recommend WPA2 with AES encryption).



On the *Teacher Account* step, create an account for the teacher.



5 Upload content


First, put the desired content into a zip file called `content_xyz.zip` where xyz can be any combination of letters and/or numbers. *Do not* include subfolders or password protect/encrypt the file. Total size must not exceed 2GB.

Go to *Device Management > Preloaded Content Database*.

Point to the location of the `content_xyz.zip` file. If using a USB drive, put the file in the root directory and plug it into the USB port of the device.

Click *Upload*.

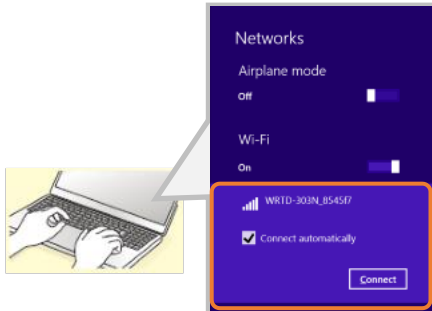

1 Connect to Content Access Point

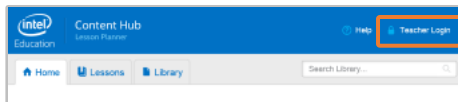
Wirelessly connect to the device.



2 Log in Teacher Account

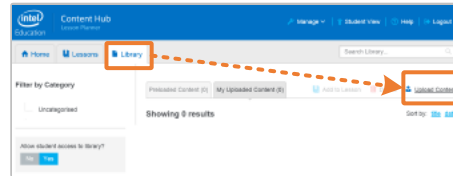
Open browser and go to <http://my.content>.

Click [Teacher Login](#) and log in with the teacher's username and password.



3 Upload content

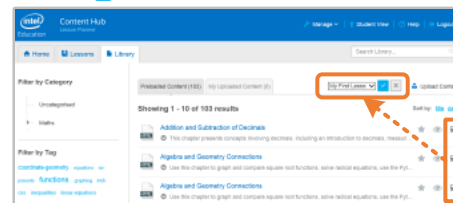
Go to the [Library](#) page, click [Upload Content](#), select content to upload, add metadata information about the content, and click [Upload](#).



4 Add content to a lesson

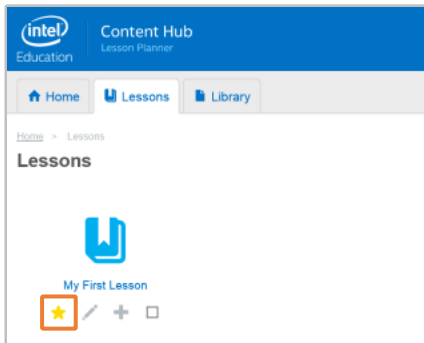
Go to the [Lessons](#) page and click [Create a New Lesson](#).

Go to the [Library](#) page, checkmark desired content, click the [Add to Lesson](#) button, select the lesson from the dropdown list, and click the button.



5 Feature important lessons and content

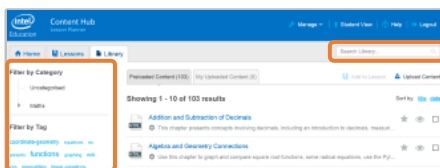
To feature a lesson or content, click the ★ button associated with it. The featured item will appear in the [Home](#) page.



6 Search

To search for content, go to [Home](#) or [Library](#) page and enter keyword(s) in the Search field. Or search by filtering based on a category or a tag in the Library.

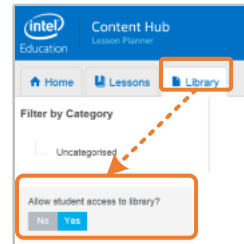
To search for lessons, go to [Lessons](#) page and enter the lesson name in the Search field.



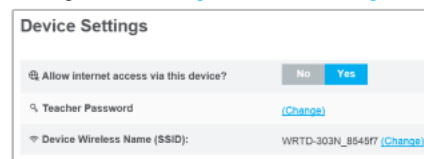
7 Useful tips!

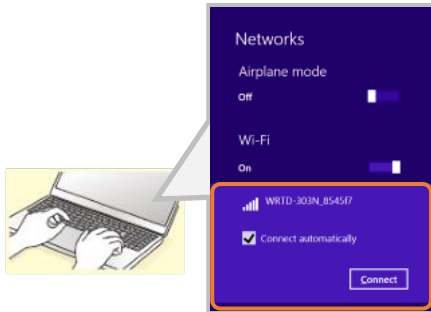

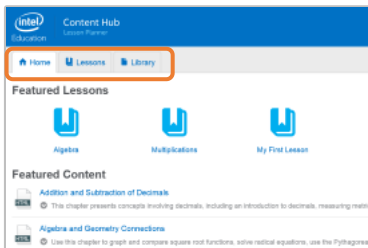
2 Lesson and content

To see all content, go to the [Library](#) page if it's made accessible.

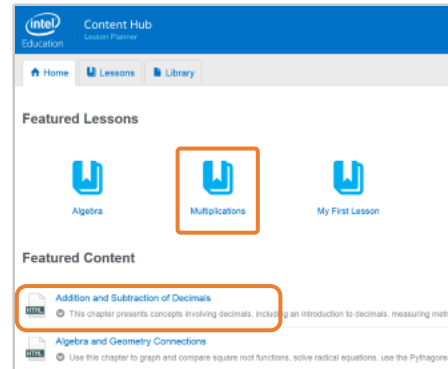


3 Open lesson and content

To open a lesson and see content within, click it.

To open a content, click it and it will appear in a new browser tab.

If it cannot be viewed by the browser, it will be downloaded to the default *Downloads* location. Use an appropriate app to open it.



4 Search
